

Judge to see Escuela files

District Judge Santiago Campos settled two motions today at a hearing on Escuela Colegio Tonantzin and then decided to look at the controversial school's files before proceeding on two other motions.

Campos apparently satisfied attorneys for the school that two motions seeking to block a narrative report by the Santa Fe County Grand Jury weren't necessary.

Standing instructions to the grand jury prevent the issuance of a narrative report on anything other than prisoners or penal facilities.

"That should take care of those two motions," Campos said. He then ordered district attorneys to bring files seized from the school to his chambers for study.

The two remaining motions seek to prevent the school's files from being introduced as evidence to the grand jury.
